Sermon Discussion Questions

The Freedom of the Religion of the Cross

Galatians 6:7-18

1. In Paul's time and in ours, people mock God regularly. Why does it say, "God cannot be mocked" (Gal. 6:7 NIV)?
 2. Doing good can be hard work (Gal. 6:9). What are some tips for rising above crippling weariness?
 3. Who wanted "to avoid being persecuted for the cross of Christ" (Gal. 6:12) and why? Where do we see this mentality today?
 4. It says that through Christ's cross, "the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world" (Gal. 6:14). What does that mean in our personal lives and in our church?
 5. Galatians concludes with the claim that "what counts is the new creation" (Gal. 6:15). What is this "new creation" and why does it count so much?
 6. Discuss some of the blessings of God making us a new creation when we choose to follow Jesus.
 7. Spend time thanking God for the blessings that you just discussed.
