Sermon Discussion Questions

The Authority of the Church, Matthew 16:18-19, Matthew 18:15-20

1. What kind of authority does a church have in the lives of people who are members? Can you think of healthy and unhealthy expressions of authority churches have had over people?
 2. Compare Mt 16:18-19 with Mt 18:15-20. What can the church “bind” and “loose”?
 3. In verse 15, you are to go point out the fault of another, not wait for them to come to you. What kind of “sins” should you go and point out? How often?
 4. What is the flow and process of church discipline in Matthew 18:15-17?
 5. What is the message members send in church discipline and how do they send it?
 6. What kind of message does a church send if they never do church discipline?
 7. If you were in need of someone exhorting you to repent and be faithful to Jesus, what would you want someone to say to you and how should they say it?
 8. Why is church discipline a mark of a healthy church?
 9. Notice the parables that surround Matthew 18:15-20. One is on seeking out lost sheep. The other is on an unmerciful servant. Why are these parables placed on either side of a passage on church discipline?
