The Leaders Of The Church, 1 Peter 5: 1 - 4

1. What is an elder?
 2. What are the qualifications for an elder?
 3. Discuss the difference and implication of these two statements:
 - a. E-Free is Darren's Church.
 - b. Darren is one of the pastors at E-Free Church.
 4. Describe from the text the way elders are supposed to lead. Discuss experiences with elders that have led a church for the right reasons.
 5. Look at the list of ways an elder should not lead. Discuss experiences with elders that have led a church for the wrong reasons.
 6. What does it mean for an elder to “lord it over” someone in the church?
 7. What are the kinds of things an elder should do? Does the size of the church change an elder's role?
 8. What should submission to the elders entail?
 9. Why does Peter link submission, humility, and God's approval/disapproval to how a church relates to elders and elders to the church.
