Sermon Discussion Questions

Leprosy & The Gospel, Leviticus 13-14

1. Share something that stood out to you in the message on Sunday?
 2. One of the points from the sermon was that physical illnesses and deformities in the Bible provide a window into greater spiritual realities. Besides leprosy, what other diseases or conditions in the Bible might point to our spiritual deficiencies before God?
 3. One of the most dreaded aspects of leprosy was the separation and isolation it created. Discuss how sin affects us in our human relationships by creating isolation.
 4. What is the significance of the priest declaring the leper clean after examination? How might that relate to passages such as Hebrews 3:1; 4:14-15; and Matthew 8:2-3?
 5. In Lev. 14:4-9, a blood sacrifice was required for a leper to be readmitted into the camp of God's people. Relate this to the work of Christ on the cross and what his blood sacrifice accomplished for those who believe. See Eph. 1:7 and I John 1:7.
 6. In Lev. 14:14-18, oil was to be put on the leper's body and poured over his head. What significance might the oil have in relation the blessing of our new birth?
 7. How does the story of Namaan and his leprosy relate to how some people view and respond to the gospel message?
 8. Share some ways that you have experienced the impact of being welcomed into God's family by other believers.
