God's Comfort In Suffering, 2 Corinthians 1: 3-11

1. What do we learn about God's nature in our suffering?
2. How does experiencing God in suffering help us? Describe an experience when God met you in the midst of suffering.
3. Why is it important to be transparent to God and others in the midst of suffering?
4. What is the church's role in supporting those who are suffering inside and outside the church?

Key applications about how God wants to use suffering

- View God in our suffering through the lens of the Bible-not through our own human experiences.
 - Be transparent and real to both God and others.
 - Be a conduit of comfort to others by stepping into hard places.
