Sermon Discussion Questions

Baptism in the Church, Col 2:8-15

1. If you have been baptized, share your story about that decision. If you haven't been baptized yet, what are your questions or concerns?
 2. Did any part of the sermon stand out, or confuse you? Discuss.
 3. Why should someone be baptized?
 4. In the Evangelical Free Church denomination, we are "open" on baptism. That means people can join our church with different convictions on baptism. Can you briefly describe the Presbyterian, Lutheran, and Baptist views of baptism and how they differ from a Catholic view? Summarize your own view.
 5. Think through the covenants mentioned in the sermon and the sign for each one. How is baptism a sign of the new covenant?
 6. The only time individuals who baptize others are mentioned in the New Testament is when it became a problem in Corinth (1 Cor 1:13-17). Why is the emphasis not on who is baptizing, but being baptized into Christ and the body of Christ?
 7. Baptism isn't just the decision of a person who wants to be baptized, but of a church to go public with this person's faith, as they are baptized into the body of Christ. How does baptism relate to membership and becoming accountable to the body of Christ?
 8. If we are to make disciples and then baptize the disciples we make, how do we know what makes someone a true disciple?
 9. Here are some harder questions on baptism to discuss: What age should someone be baptized? Should someone be rebaptized if they were baptized as an infant? Should baptisms be spontaneous? Should baptism be required for membership? Should baptismal beliefs cause division?
