Sermon Discussion Questions

Communion In the Church, I Corinthians 11:17-34

1. Discuss the ways that you have seen communion practiced in churches.
 2. Try to summarize various views of the Lord's Supper within Christianity (Catholic, Lutheran, Reformed, Baptist).
 3. In most churches, the "meal" is a small piece of bread/wafer and grape juice/wine. Does it matter what we eat or drink? Could we, for example, substitute our grape juice with Coke?
 4. How does someone become qualified to take communion? Or, who may take it?
 5. How do baptism and communion relate to each other?
 6. Look at Exodus 12:1-22 for the background of Passover. Then read Luke 22:17-20, when at Passover Jesus institutes the Lord's Supper. Discuss how the Lord's Supper and Passover relate to one another.
 7. Read 1 Corinthians 11:23-32 together. How were people treating each other? What is Paul trying to teach us and the Corinthians?
 8. What does it mean to take communion "in remembrance"?
 9. Churches often make communion a solemn event. In Acts 2 believers are filled with joy in the breaking of bread. Is it likely that such joy and enthusiasm would arise from a solemn remembrance of the Last Supper?
 10. What should we be thinking about when we take communion?
