Sermon Discussion Questions

Prayer Changes Everything, Philippians 4:4-9

1. Share about a time when God answered one of your prayers. How did that answer to prayer impact your faith?
 2. Share a story about a time where you tried to do something on your own, without prayer. What was the outcome?
 3. Read Philippians 4:4-9
 - a. How does prayer help you rejoice in the Lord?
 - b. How does prayer impact anxiety?
 - c. What is the peace of God?
 - d. How does prayer change our thought lives?
 4. How does prayer impact our relationship with God?
 5. How does prayer impact our relationship with other people?
 6. Knowing what is promised to us through prayer, why do you think it is so easy for us to neglect our prayer lives?
 7. How would life be different if you truly prayed about all things? (If you're doing this, share about the difference prayer makes).
 8. How would our church be different if we were a people that prayed about all things?
 9. Consider what changes you need to make to be a man or woman of prayer. Starting today, what steps are you going to take to be a person who prays in every situation?
 10. Spend time praying together. Follow Paul's instructions in Philippians 4:6.
 - Pray, refers to intercession
 - Pray for other people, stand in the gap on their behalf
 - Petition - make your requests known to God, pray specifically (remember the second "request" teaches us to pray specifically, not wordy or generic prayers)
 - Thanksgiving - thank God for his gifts, blessings, and praise Him for who He is
