SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Taking God Seriously - Acts 5:1-11

1. What do you do when you come to passages in the Bible that make you feel uncomfortable? For you, what makes a passage hard?
 2. What did Ananias and Sapphira do that warranted God taking their life?
 3. Compare Barnabas (Acts 4:37) and Ananias. How are they different?
 4. Compare Joshua 7 (Story of Achan) with the story of Ananias. Why is the punishment so severe?
 5. It seems Ananias and Sapphira want to be known for extreme generosity without actually being generous. Discuss what this would look like if it happened in our church.
 6. What does it mean to lie to the Holy Spirit?
 7. If God were to do this in our church, why would he do it and what would be the result?
 8. Fear strikes two groups (v11) - those in the church and those who heard about it. How does fear function in both of those groups?
